## ORDINANCES

1. To provide for the removal of certain monuments on City-owned property, provide for the disposition of such monuments, and repeal an ordinance accepting the General Thomas J. “Stonewall” Jackson monument, adopted Mar. 3, 1920, as authorized by Va. Code § 15.2-1812. (Mr. Jones, Mrs. Lynch, and Mr. Addison) **{Land Use, Housing and Transportation – July 21, 2020}**
2. To establish a Task Force on the Establishment of a Civilian Review Board to review and provide recommendations concerning the creation of such a board. (Mrs. Lynch, Mr. Jones, Mr. Addison, President Newbille, and Mrs. Robertson) **{Governmental Operations – July 23, 2020}**

## RESOLUTIONS

3. To request that the Chief Administrative Officer cause to be established a work group of certain employees of the City and a member of the Council to develop a plan and recommendations for the implementation of a “Marcus Alert” program by October 1, 2020. (Mr. Jones, Mrs. Lynch, and President Newbille) **{Education and Human Services – July 2, 2020}**
4. To request that the Chief Administrative Officer cause to be prepared and submitted to the Council Finance and Economic Development Standing Committee a quarterly report that provides certain data relevant to the City’s five civil asset forfeiture special funds for the purpose of increased oversight of the sources and uses of civil asset forfeiture special funds. (Mrs. Lynch and Mr. Jones) **{Finance and Economic Development – July 16, 2020}**
5. To request that the Chief Administrative Officer cause to be prepared and submitted to the Council and the Mayor a report identifying funding in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 General Fund Budget and the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Special Fund Budget appropriated to the Department of Police for mental health, substance abuse, and social service functions and that provides recommendations, to the extent permitted by law, for the re-appropriation and transfer of such funding from the Department of Police to other City departments and to community mental health, substance abuse, and social service programs designed to perform such functions. (Mrs. Lynch and Mr. Jones) **{Finance and Economic Development – July 16, 2020}**

6. To request that the Chief Administrative Officer cause the Department of Police to revise its policies to ban the use of certain non-lethal weapons to control unlawful assemblies. (Mrs. Lynch and Mr. Jones) **{Public Safety – July 28, 2020}**
