To provide for the granting by the City of Richmond to the person, firm or corporation to be ascertained in the manner prescribed by law of certain easements upon, over, under, and across certain property located at 3301 Maplewood Avenue for the construction, installation, operation, maintenance, inspection, repair, replacement, and removal of telecommunications lines and associated appurtenances in accordance with a certain Right of Way Agreement.

Bill Echelberger, council budget analyst, provided an overview of the proposed ordinance.

Councilor Addison supported an amendment to RES. 2019-R050 to include city administration's recommendation.

There were no further comments or discussions and **Member Michael Jones moved to forward** RES. 2019-R050 to Council with the recommendation to approve with amendment, which was seconded and unanimously approved.

The following resolution was considered:

RES. 2020-R011

To express the City Council's support for and request the Commonwealth Transportation Board to provide funding for the City's SMART SCALE candidate projects for 2020.

ORD. 2020-027

To grant to the County of Chesterfield, Virginia a temporary construction easement upon, over, under, and across a certain portion of the City-owned real estate known as 8850 West Huguenot Road.

Rosemary Green, Department of Public Utilities Water Treatment deputy director, introduced ORD. 2020-027.

There were no comments or discussions and **Member Michael Jones moved to forward ORD.** 2020-027 to Council with the recommendation to approve, which was seconded and unanimously approved.

The following ordinance was considered:

ORD. 2020-028

To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Lease Agreement between Enrichmond Foundation, as Lessee, and the City of Richmond, as Lessor, to allow Enrichmond Foundation to lease office and warehouse space at 1500 East Franklin Street.

Bill Echelberger, council budget analyst, provided an overview of ORD. 2020-028.

Paul McClellan, Economic Development programs administrator, introduced ORD. 2020-028 and explained the lease would be for term of five years and that the city would retain its right to terminate the lease in accordance with the proposed lease.

Member Michael Jones inquired about the fair market rental rate for the subject property.

Mr. McClellan explained the proposed lease was submitted and approved by the Federal Transit Administration as a part of Main Street Station, and the market rental rate was based on the current condition of the warehouse.

There were no further comments or discussions and **Member Michael Jones moved to forward** ORD. 2020-028 to Council with the recommendation to approve, which was seconded and unanimously approved.

Discussion Item(s)

It was the consensus of the committee to have a presentation regarding the city's economic development plan at an upcoming Finance and Economic Development Standing Committee meeting. Member Michael Jones asked Deputy Council Chief of Staff Meghan Brown to coordinate the presentation.

Chair Ellen Robertson asked Council staff to also coordinate a presentation on the city's housing strategy for an upcoming Land Use, Housing and Transportation Standing Committee meeting.
