I had the opportunity to attend the previous UDC hearing regarding the Brown's Island Improvement Plan when Committee members very astutely requested that the plans for Brown's Island be improved by decreasing the excessive hardscaping shown the plan. Objections were appropriately made to the Hollywood-like Brown's Island sign.

Unfortunately, the new proposal for an excessive Brown's Island sign should also be removed from the plan. Perhaps this strange concrete tower is supposed to somehow evoke the authentic stone bridge footings on Brown's Island?
