Collective Bargaining

Focusing on making the City of Richmond an employer of choice, the City Council is supporting our core employees by dedicating \$27 million to Collective Bargaining per year.

Richmond City Schools

With a deep commitment to our schools and children, The City of Richmond has increased the RPS budget by over \$97.3 million dollars since 2017.

Public Mobility and Infrastructure

We have made critical improvements to our roads, ensuring safety and reliability for all users. City Council is committed to expanding connectivity across the City.
