

Minority Business Enterprise and Emerging Small Business Advisory Board

- One (1) member who shall be either an at-large resident of the city or a member of the Council The Mayor shall nominate:
 - 2 members who shall be representatives of a minority business enterprise,
 - 1 member who shall be a representative of lenders or businesses other than a minority business enterprise
 - 1 member who shall be a Section 3 contractor representative

The Board may elect from its membership a chairman and other officers it deems necessary in accordance with its rules of procedure or bylaws.
