

PURPOSE: To appropriate funds donated to the Richmond Department of Social Services Healthy Families Program by the First Unitarian Universalist Church of Richmond in support of efforts to celebrate client achievements through individual and group activities.

REASON: Per ordinance 2017-120, regarding the form of budget amendments submitted to Council, this amendment seeks to appropriate \$1,790.81 donated by the First Unitarian Universalist Church of Richmond to the Department of Social Services FY18 Special Fund Budget for the Healthy Families Program.

RECOMMENDATION: The City Administration and Department of Social Services recommend adoption of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND: Healthy Families America (HFA) is a nationally recognized evidence-based home visiting program model designed to work with overburdened families who are at-risk for adverse childhood experiences including child maltreatment. It is the primary home visiting program model best suited to work with families who may have histories of trauma, intimate partner violence, mental health and/or substance abuse issues. Healthy Families services begin prenatally or immediately shortly after the birth of a baby and are offered voluntarily, intensively and until the child turns three (3) years of age. Healthy Families Richmond is one of 35 Healthy Families Programs in Virginia.
