1. THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:
2. § 1. That Section 29-286 of the Code of the City of
3. Richmond, 1985, be and is hereby amended and reordained as
4. follows:
5. Sec. 29-286. Authority of director.
6. Wherever parking meters have been installed and are
7. maintained upon the highways of the city for the regulation
8. of parking of vehicles thereon, the director shall determine
9. the length of time in minutes or hours during which any
10. vehicle may be parked on any such highway. [~~Whenever the~~
11. ~~director shall determine that the length of time during~~
12. ~~which any vehicle may be parked shall be regulated on an~~
13. ~~hourly basis, the regulation shall permit lawful parking for~~
14. ~~not less than two (2) hours.] The director shall make,~~

1. promulgate and enforce rules and regulations as to the
2. parking of vehicles on such highways, and it shall be
3. unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on any such
4. highway for a longer period of time than that fixed by the
5. director or to violate any such rule or regulation made and
6. promulgated by him, and upon conviction thereof, every such
7. person shall be punished as provided in section 29-34.

8. § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect July
9. 1, 1986.
