submitted its report to the City Clerk;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the intersections of Cutshaw Avenue and

Roseneath Road, Cutshaw Avenue and Tilden Street, Cutshaw Avenue and Cleveland Street, and

Cutshaw Avenue and North Belmont Avenue.

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may

be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs

have been erected at the aforesaid intersections.
