### **CHAMBER EVACUATION PLAN AND CITIZEN SPEAKER GUIDELINES**

Council President Michelle Mosby called the meeting to order at 5:14 p.m. and presided. Upon the President's request, Candice Reid, Deputy City Clerk, provided information on the appropriate manner in which the Council Chamber is to be evacuated in the event of an emergency along with citizen speaker guidelines and conduct during the meeting.

### **PAPERS FOR CONSIDERATION**

**The following resolution was considered:**

#### **RES. 2016-R010**

To support the City of Richmond's application for the United States Department of Transportation Smart City Challenge for a grant of up to \$50,000,000.00 for the purpose of funding projects designed to use advanced technologies to address transportation for disadvantaged populations and improving access to jobs.

*Michael Sawyer, City Transportation Engineer, Department of Public Works, introduced proposed Res. 2016-R010, stating that the paper supports the city's application for the United States Department of Transportation's Smart City Challenge submitted on February 4, 2016, and that the Richmond Highway Safety Commission adopted a resolution of support for the challenge on January 15, 2016. Mr. Sawyer also stated that the city is competing against 77 other cities across the country for a one time grant of \$50,000,000 to demonstrate new technology aimed at transforming the nation's transportation systems.*

**The following resolution was considered:**

RES. 2016-R011

To support the development of a Vision Zero program in the City of Richmond with the goal of reducing traffic fatalities and serious injuries in road traffic to zero by the year 2030.

*Michael Sawyer, City Transportation Engineer, Department of Public Works, introduced Res. 2016-R010 and stated that it was recommended by the Richmond Highway Safety Commission at their January 15, 2016 meeting. He also stated that the Department of Public Works supports the paper to incorporate vision zero into the next comprehensive master planning efforts.*

*Councilor Jonathan Baliles stated that Resolutions 2016-R010 and 2016-R011 give the city an opportunity to win a \$50,000,000 grant to improve every level of safety on city streets.*

**Support**

**John Bolecek**, Chair, Highway Safety Commission, spoke in support of the proposed legislation stating that Richmond has to focus more on preventing traffic crashes, so the vision zero approach looks at crashes as preventable incidents that can be systematically addressed. Mr. Bolecek thanked Council for its support of the very important legislation that will help save lives.
