Through meetings and online tools, residents share and discuss ideas for projects.

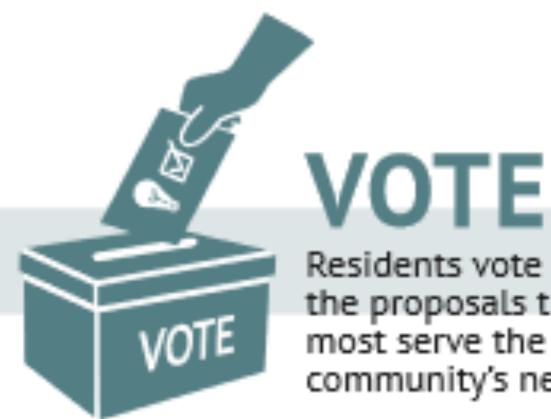


### DEVELOP PROPOSALS

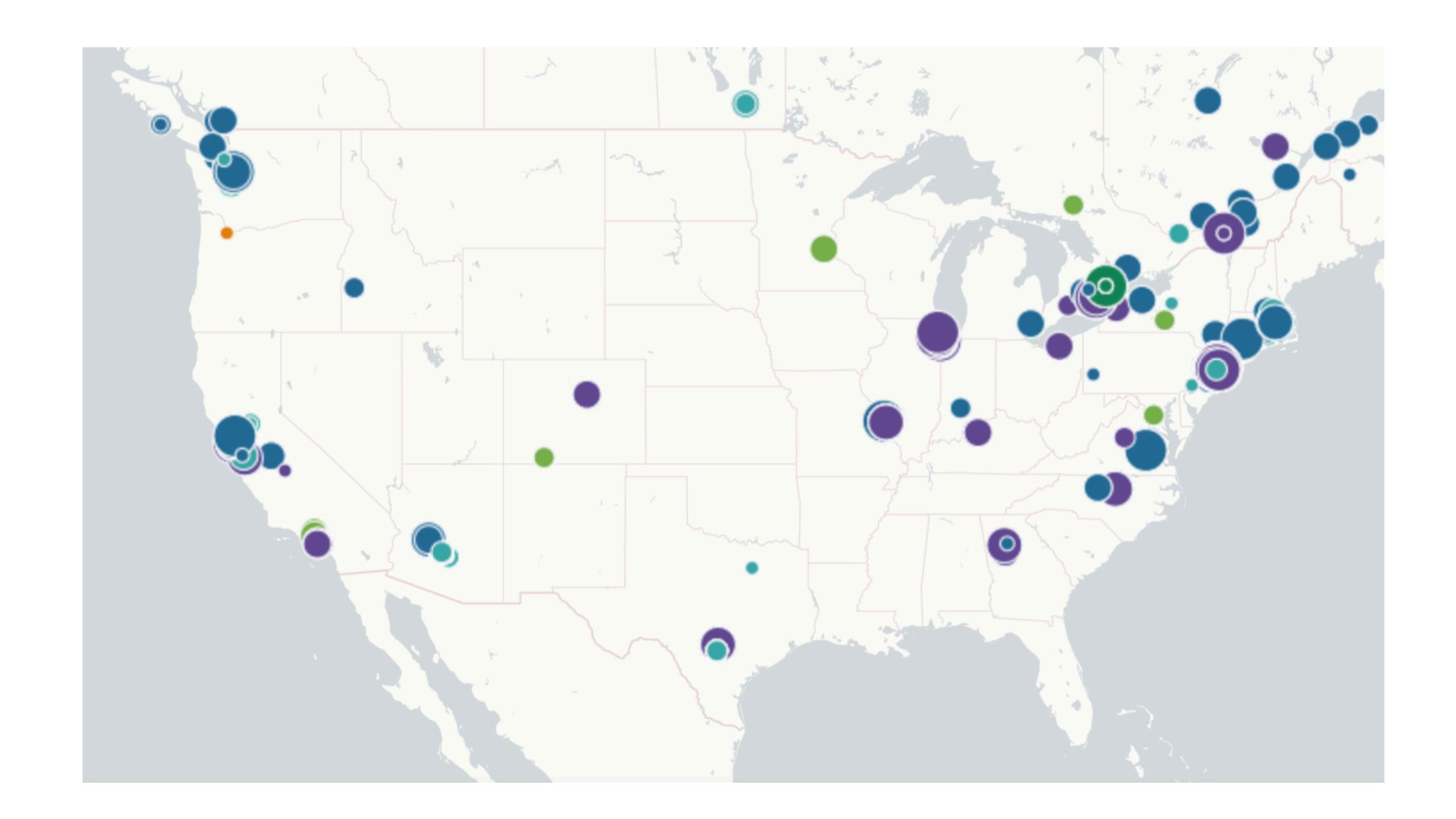
Volunteer "budget delegates" develop the ideas into feasible proposals.

### WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

Aligns public fundings with community needs/values in a more direct way.

Builds the capacity of residents to be active participants in budgeting process.

Meets people where they are at and scaffolds engagement developing trust.

The focus is on tangibility, transparency, accountability, actionability, equity.

Pairs the lived experience of Community with the knowledge of City Hall.

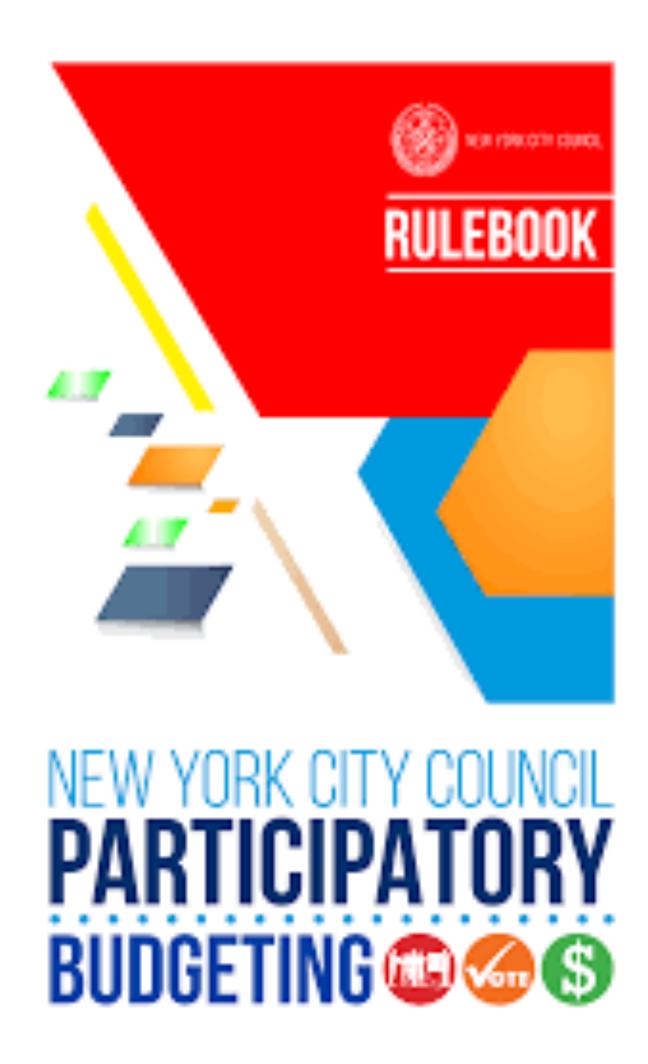

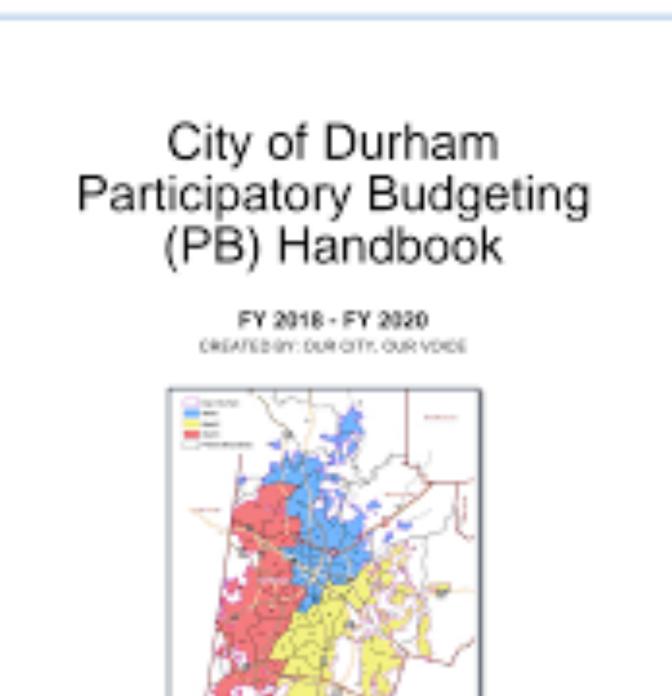

## BUDGET

2019 Ordinance - \$15million CIP over 5 years = \$3million per year Operation + Implementation

FY 2022 - \$100,000 Planning (Used)

FY 2023 - \$100,000 Planning (Phase2a)

**FY 2024 - \$200,000 (Phase 2b - FTEs, City Infrastructure)** 

Cycle 1

**FY 2025 - \$350,000 (Staffing and Operations)** 

FY 2026 - \$3mil (CIP) + \$200,000 (Implementation/Evaluation)

Cycle 2

FY 2027 - \$350,000

FY 2028 - \$5mil (CIP?) + \$200,000

Cycle 3

FY 2029 - \$350,000

FY 2030 - \$7mil (CIP?) + \$200,000
