Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR)

Lenora Reid, deputy chief administrative officer – Finance and Administration, presented Council with a draft of the Fiscal Year 2016 CAFR and introduced the city's external audit partner, CliftonLarsonAllen (CLA), LLP's Greg Bussink. Mr. Bussink provided information regarding their findings and stated that CLA expects to deliver a clean (unmodified) opinion of the city's finances by the end of April. A copy of the information has been filed.

President Chris Hilbert arrived at 4:10 p.m. and was seated.

Roland Kooch, Davenport and Company senior vice president, was also in attendance and provided information regarding the city's unassigned fund balance and bond rating. Mr. Kooch recommended that, to maintain the city's current AA bond rating, Council should not utilize any "one-time dollars" (unassigned funds) to balance fiscal year budgets without the adoption of a sound policy.

Chief Administrative Officer Selena Cuffee-Glenn was also available to answer questions regarding the unassigned fund balance and stated that the mayor welcomes the opportunity to work with Council to change current policy to address its usage and growth.
