To access and/or participate in the Public Art Commission meeting on Thursday, September 22, at 4:30 PM, you have several options:

1. Access the meeting by phone

You may listen to the meeting (audio only) from your phone by dialing +1 804-316-9457 and when prompted, enter conference ID 268 226 271 569

2.
