- This detailed quarterly report shall include:
  - Spending progress,
  - Outcomes of initiatives that are being funded, and
  - o Any shifts in priorities, and
  - Any additional ARPA funds received through the Commonwealth of Virginia, or other sources.
- The report shall be submitted to City Council, and presentations thereon shall be provided quarterly beginning January, 2022 at meetings of the Richmond City Council Finance and Economic Development and Organizational Development Standing Committees.

# **BACKGROUND**

• The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, H.R. 1319, was passed by the 117th Cong., 1st Sess. (2021-2022), and Signed into law by President Biden on March 11, 2021.

- The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) allocates approximately \$154.8 million directly to the City of Richmond, additional funds may be received indirectly through the Commonwealth of Virginia.
- The \$154.8 million to be received directly by the city, will be provided by the U. S. Treasury in two tranches of \$77.4 million:
  - o The first tranche was received on, 2021, and
  - o The second tranche will be received in calendar 2022.
- Richmond City Council has undertaken an extensive process to determine its priorities for the use of funds received under the American Rescue Plan Act.
- On October 25, 2021 City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2021-291, which had been introduced by the Mayor, and which appropriates the first tranche of \$77.4 million.
