

RCSO INMATE CORNER
















The National Center for Construction Education and Research (NCCER) Core Curriculum is a prerequisite to all other Level 1 craft curriculum. Its modules cover topics such as Basic Safety, Communication Skills and Introduction to Construction Drawings. Completing this curriculum gives the trainee the basic skills needed to continue education in any craft area he or she chooses. This class was held three days a week virtually with the exception of CPR which was held face to face. Richmond City Sheriff's Office has had six residents (4 pictured) to complete the NCCER to include CPR.
