

2. Describe your project.

A shipping container to serve as a storage unit for tools & materials for the garden. The container will be equipped with solar panels to provide a power source for tools, since there is no electrical source present. The container will also have murals painted on it to increase aesthetic appearance of the garden overall.

3. Describe your strategy for engaging the public.

We will collaborate with garden organizers about the design for the container murals and seek community volunteers to help with the installation process.

4. Attach a detailed budget, not to exceed \$30,000.

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5. How do you plan to ensure the security of the tool shed component?

Locks, with keys given to community organization leaders


6. Describe your installation plan.

Shipping container will be delivered to site and stationed. Solar panel kit and lights will be installed by a technician. A ramp for accessibility will be built for the container. After installation is complete, artists will execute artwork on the container.




