Brief Biography

William E. Echelberger, Jr.

Bill Echelberger has a long history in Virginia State and local government. After graduation from Virginia Tech he began his career at the Virginia Department of Planning and Budget (DPB) in 1977. While with DPB he progressed through multiple areas from higher education to general government, and budget planning and policy. In 1986 Bill joined the staff of the Senate of Virginia's Finance Committee. While with the Finance Committee he assisted the Virginia Senate with budget and legislative policy in such diverse areas as constitutional officers, general government, capital projects, employee compensation, health benefits, and retirement. In the 1980s Bill was heavily involved in development of the legislation and constitutional revisions governing the Virginia Lottery. In the 1990s, he was the principal author of the cutting-edge Virginia Sickness and Disability Program for state employees, in the 2000s Bill played a key role in the historic renovation and expansion of the Virginia State Capitol, and the 2012 reforms of the Virginia Retirement System.

Bill retired from the Senate staff in 2012 after thirty-five years in state government, twenty five of which were as staff to the Senate Finance Committee.

After a brief time spent painting, scuba diving, and hiking in the Andes Mountains, Bill returned to public service in 2014. From 2014 to 2022 he was on the staff of Richmond City Council Chief of Staff Office as a budget analyst. Bill is now retired for the second time.
