PURPOSE: To amend Ord. No. 2022-057 adopted May 9 2022, which adopted the Capital Improvement Plan for fiscal year 2022-2023 and to authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to accept federal funds in the total amount of \$1,357,809.00 from the Virginia Department of Transportation and to appropriate the revenues to the resurfacing of "UPC 121676 Belt Blvd N; UPC 121677 Broad Rock Blvd S; UPC 121678 Broad Rock Blvd N and UPC 121679 Broad Rock Blvd N" in the Transportation Category under "Complete Streets Project- Award # 501100".

REASON: To accept and appropriate \$1,357,809.00 from VDOT FY 2021 Primary Extension Paving Program State of Good Repair (SGR) funds. These funds were approved by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) for the City of Richmond in June 2021.

RECOMMENDATION: The department of Public works recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND: House Bill 1887 requires funding to be provided for Primary Extension Paving Program for U.S. Routes and Virginia State Routes. The program must include the condition of the existing transportation assets; the methodology used to determine maintenance and performance targets and outcomes; listings of prioritized pavement projects based on priority ranking system.

The bill requires the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) to develop a priority ranking system for deteriorated pavement on Primary Arterial Roads. The Primary Extension Paving Program is a federal funded state wide program and the City of Richmond submitted the application for; Belt Blvd N from Terminal Ave. to 300 feet short of Walmsley Blvd (estimated cost \$356,103.00); Broad Rock Blvd S from Terminal Ave to 500 feet short of Walmsley Blvd (estimated cost \$369,005.00) Broad Rock Blvd N from 100 feet past Cranford Ave to Snead Rd (estimated cost \$449,921.00 and Broad Rock Blvd N from 100 feet short of Plainfield Rd to Snead Rd (estimated cost \$324,780.00).

The scope of this project consist of milling, resurfacing and handicap upgrades for and estimated cost of \$1,499,809.00

The (Belt Blvd N; Broad Rock Blvd S and Broad Rock Blvd N) were submitted in December 2021 and received approval for funding from Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) in June 2022 in the total amount of \$1,499,809.00. Breakdown of the \$1,499,809.00 equates to VDOT administrative cost \$142,000.00, reimbursable federal funds to City for construction \$1,357,809.00

This ordinance is to provide amendment to the FY 2023 CIP budget to appropriate \$1,357,809.00 from federal funds for the resurfacing of Belt Blvd N from Terminal Ave. to 300 feet short of Walmsley Blvd; Broad Rock Blvd S from Terminal Ave to 500 feet short of Walmsley Blvd; Broad Rock Blvd N from 100 feet past Cranford Ave to Snead Rd and Broad Rock Blvd N from 100 feet short of Plainfield Rd to Snead Rd, in the Transportation Category in "Complete Streets Project - Award # 501100".
