#### Minority Business Enterprise and Emerging Small Business Advisory Board



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

In the midst of those experiences, I determined that, were I ever to have the means, I would do my utmost to ensure that those living rough in Richmond would have access to resources that I desperately needed growing up. I have since achieved a level of success that I could scarcely have dreamed of as a child. I am now a husband, a father, a foodie, a fitness devotee, and a successful
