PROJECT SUMMARY

A mural will be installed on the façade of an abandoned gas station that sits atop the long-neglected Shockoe Hill African Burying Ground. The mural commemorates the site in the interim until a more complete design of the site can be developed. The rationale for the installation is general beautification and to cover the existing graffiti on the wall of the abandoned gas station on the site, as well as to create a mural for the Shockoe Hill African Burying Ground, honoring
