#### THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That section 9-58 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2020) be and is hereby

amended and reordained as follows:

#### Sec. 9-58. Polling places.

Pursuant to Code of Virginia, §§ 24.2-310 and 24.2-310.1, the polling places for each of

the precincts established in this article shall be as follows:

#### ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

To amend City Code § 9-58, which assigns polling places in the city, to relocate the polling places for Precinct 909 and Precinct 910.

#### BACKGROUND

This O&R requests that City Code § 9-58 be amended to relocate the polling place for Precincts 909 and 910.

The current polling place for precinct 909 – Elizabeth Redd Elementary School located at 5601 Jahnke Road and the proposed new location is at Liberation Church, which is located at 5200 Midlothian Turnpike. The current polling place for precinct 910 is GH Reid Elementary School located at 1301 Whitehead Road and the proposed new location is at River City Middle School Henry Marsh, located at 6300 Hull Street. Both Precinct 909, Elizabeth Redd Elementary, and Precinct 910, G.H. Reid Elementary, are older buildings that lack the modern amenities that can be found at Liberation Church and River City Middle School, which are newer, more modernized, and larger buildings providing greater accessibility and ease of access for voters.

This ordinance requests to relocate the polling places for Precincts 909 to Liberation Church, 5200 Midlothian Turnpike and 910 to River City Middle School, 6300 Hull Street. The Office of the General Registrar will provide notice of the changes to all voters by mail. This change is not expected to have any fiscal impact; therefore, no budget amendment is requested at this time. It is anticipated that this

notice will be mailed to all voters in August. Section 24.2-306 of the Code of Virginia prohibits changes to polling places within 60 days of a general election. As such, this ordinance must be adopted by July 22, 2024. Notice of this proposed change must be published prior to enactment once a week for two successive weeks before adoption.

The requested introduction date is April 22, 2024.


