Description of Exterior Work at 2610 East grace Street

General

All painted colors to be picked from city approved pallete

All previous painted components to be repainted

All missing mortar to be repointed with matching mortar

Front Elevation

Windows

All broken windows to be reglazed and repainted

Porch (partially Original)

Demo 70's rebuild of roof salvage metal shingles for reuse

Replace T&G wood flooring in kind. Floor to be painted

Repair and replace original columns and spandrel panel

Reframe porch roof to closely resemble original roof in shape and slope

New roof will utilize hidden box gutters with salvaged shingles as roof cladding.

Porch rail to made of turned wooden balusters (height of rail to match markings on existing column)

Decorative Cast Iron Roof Rail

We believe this is rail has been salvaged by the current owner if so this rail will be reinstalled.

Back Porch (Built in 1970's)

Remove non historic spiral stair

Replace T&G flooring in kind


Clad exposed PT columns and band board with 1X material to be painted

Construct simple picket rail

Back Addition (Built 1970's)

Remove laundry room addition in it's entirety


Restore current brick openings similar to left front window of front elevation.






Evidence of top rail Evidence of bottom

Replace T& G in kind





