RESOLUTION OF THE RICHMOND CITY PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVING A SECTION 17.05 REVIEW OF THE "FIND ART DOORS" TEMPORARY PUBLIC ART INSTALLATION

WHEREAS, a request has been submitted by Virginia Supportive Housing and Art on Wheels to allow a temporary public art installation at various city-owned locations for a duration of five months. The art installation is a series of forty (40) uniquely painted, free-standing 39" x 72" doors. Installation is tentatively set for late June through early July of 2015.

WHEREAS, the applicant will be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the doors and will seek the proper permits from the Department of Parks & Recreation, the Department of Public Works, or any other agency which may oversee the city-owned locations, prior to installation.

WHEREAS, the applicant presented the proposal to the Public Art Commission at its April 14, 2015 meeting. Upon a motion made by Ms. Driggs and seconded by Ms. Cunningham, the Public Art Commission voted (7,0) to recommend approval of the temporary public art installation known as "Find Art Doors" at various city-owned locations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Planning Commission of the City of Richmond, Virginia, reviewed the proposal in accordance with Section 17.05 of the City Charter (2005), as amended,

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Planning Commission having held a public hearing on the proposed temporary art installation on April 20, 2015, hereby approves said proposal.
