We propose to construct a screened-in porch at the rear of our house in place of an existing porch that is in poor condition and structurally unsound. The porch will occupy the footprint of an earlier porch that ran along the width of the rear. It will be compatible with neighboring porches and constructed of materials also compatible with comparable structures in the surrounding district of Church Hill. We propose also improving the front porch of our house to make it compatible with the decorative features of our neighboring houses of the same period (1903). Inclyded are photographs of the

The changes involve constructing pedestals to the lower part of the columns, adding a balustrade with railings, and painting both in a palette (Sherwin Williams Victorian selection) consistent with our neighbors', thereby unifying the three houses of this unique row. We will add a half column against the wall near the lower window where the original is missing.
