WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Richmond that the City Council officially designate such property as a City park for its protection and preservation for future enjoyment by the public;

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

- § 1. That all City-owned property located within the area bounded by Dock Street to the north, Great Shiplock Park to the east, the Kanawha Canal to the south, and 21st Street to the west is hereby designated and established as a City park and placed into the City's park system.
- § 2. That, notwithstanding the provisions of sections 26-7 through 26-10 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2004), as amended, to the contrary, the park established pursuant to section 1 of this ordinance shall be named "Low Line Park."
 - § 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.
