PURPOSE: To amend and reordain the fees set forth in Appendix A of the City Code for sections 42-141(v) of the City Code, concerning rates and discounts for parking facilities operated by the City. 27. § 1. That Chapter 42, Article IV of the Code of the City of Richmond (2004) be and is hereby amended and reordained by adding therein a new section 42-141 as follows:

Sec. 42-141. Rates and discounts for parking facilities operated by the City. The rates and discounts for parking in the following City-owned off-street parking facilities shall be as set forth in Appendix A to this Code:

- (v) Gateway Garage at 800 E. Canal Street
- § 2. That Appendix A to the Code of the City of Richmond (2004) be and is hereby amended and reordained by adding therein a new fee for section 42-141 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2004) as follows:
