PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept \$99,125 from the Virginia Department of Mines Mineral & Energy and Virginia Clean Cities for the incremental cost of twelve (12) new compressed natural gas (CNG) vehicles purchased since July 2014 and to appropriate this increase to the Department of Public Works - Fleet Management Division FY16 Capital Budget (account number: 0601-02922-80007-1168) for the City Of Richmond Vehicle Replacement Program.

REASON: State agencies and local governments in the Congestion and Mitigation Air Quality (CMAQ) areas (Richmond is in the CMAQ attainment/maintenance area) may be reimbursed up to an average of \$10,000 for the incremental cost of new vehicles or reasonable aftermarket conversions.

**RECOMMENDATION:** The City Administration recommends adoption of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND: The Virginia Department of Mines Mineral and Energy and Virginia Clean Cities have made incentive funding available to local governments including Richmond, to help cover the costs of transitioning to alternative fuel vehicles, which includes compressed natural gas vehicles.

This grant is retroactive for alternative fuel vehicles purchased new or converted since July 2014. The Department of Public Works - Fleet Management Division qualifies for this grant because they purchased twelve (12) new CNG vehicles (dedicated and bi-fuel) during this period.

The Department of Public Works - Fleet Management Division will receive funding of \$99,125 from the Virginia Department of Mines Mineral and Energy in their Alternative Fuel Government Fleet Vehicle Incentive program

FISCAL IMPACT / COST: This is an incentive grant to the Department of Public Works - Fleet Management Division, which is based on purchases already made.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS: Department of Public Works - Fleet Management Division will utilize the \$99,125 over the next fiscal year to off-set the cost of purchasing additional vehicles fueled by compressed natural gas.

**REPORTING:** Per DMME requirement staff will report on the cost and the volume of the natural gas fuel for the first year of operation or one complete year of operation.
