The Commission shall consist of **nine (9) members**. The Council shall appoint seven (7) of the members. The Mayor shall appoint two (2) of the members, one of whom shall be the director of a department of the City or such director's designee.

Council shall appoint one person from each of the following categories:

- (1) demonstrated knowledge of and experience with green business and job programs;
- (2) demonstrated knowledge of and experience with energy efficiency and conservation practices and life cycle cost analysis;
- (3) demonstrated knowledge of and experience with green high performance building standards and technology;
- (4) demonstrated knowledge of and experience with green affordable housing;
- (5) demonstrated knowledge of and experience with green infrastructure;
- (6) demonstrated knowledge and experience with renewable energy and renewable portfolio standards; and
- (7) demonstrated knowledge of and experience with alternative transportation and alternative fuels.

The mayor shall appoint:

- (8) a director of a department of the City or such director's designee; and
- (9) one citizen.

At least **four** of the **Council appointees shall reside in the city or have their principal place of employment in the city** in accordance with section 2-837 of this Code. The **remaining** Council **appointees and the Mayor's appointee** who is not a department director **shall not** be subject to the residency requirement or have a principal place of employment in the city. All other aspects of the commission and its membership not addressed in this division shall be governed by Chapter 2, Article V, Division 1 of the City Code.

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
