WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2001-277-288, adopted October 8, 2001, established a legal requirement that all-way stop signs be erected at the intersections of North Vine Street and Floyd Avenue; North Allen Avenue and Floyd Avenue; and North Morris Street, North Brunswick Street, and Floyd Avenue, among other intersections; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2003-297-266, adopted September 22, 2003, established a legal requirement that all-way stop signs be erected at the intersection of North Dooley Avenue and Floyd Avenue, among other intersections; and

WHEREAS, for the purpose of calming traffic, the Department of Public Works has installed roundabouts at the intersections of North Vine Street and Floyd Avenue; North Allen Avenue and Floyd Avenue; North Morris Street, North Brunswick Street, and Floyd Avenue; and North Dooley Avenue and Floyd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near these intersections to repeal the legal requirement that all-way stop signs be erected at these intersections so that the Department of Public Works may establish such regulations and post such signs and signals as may be appropriate in light of the installation of the roundabouts at these intersections; and

WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Director of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works, and more than 60 days have elapsed since such referral;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

I. That Ordinance No. 2001-277-288, adopted October 8, 2001, be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

WHEREAS, the following intersections are located in a populous residential area of the Fan District in the City:

Vine Avenue and Floyd Avenue;

Allen Avenue and Floyd Avenue;

Allen Avenue and Grove Avenue;

Allen Avenue and Hanover Avenue;

Allen Avenue and Park Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Floyd Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Grove Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Hanover Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Stuart Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Park Avenue;

Stafford Street and Hanover Avenue;

Stafford Street and Stuart Avenue; and

Morris Street, Brunswick Street and Floyd Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersections in the Fan District to erect all-way stop signs at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-200 of the Code of the City of Richmond (1993), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the City's Traffic Engineer prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works and more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since such referral. NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the following intersections:

[Vine Avenue and Floyd Avenue;]

[Allen Avenue and Floyd Avenue;]

Allen Avenue and Grove Avenue;

Allen Avenue and Hanover Avenue;

Allen Avenue and Park Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Floyd Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Grove Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Hanover Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Stuart Avenue;

Strawberry Street and Park Avenue;

Stafford Street and Hanover Avenue; and

Stafford Street and Stuart Avenue; and

[Morris Street, Brunswick Street and Floyd Avenue; and]

§ 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption, or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersections.

II. That Ordinance No. 2003-297-266, adopted September 22, 2003, be and is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

WHEREAS, the following intersections are located in a populous residential area of the City:

Patterson Avenue and North Nansemond Street;

Park Avenue and North Nansemond Street;

Hanover Avenue and Tilden Street;

Stuart Avenue and Tilden Street;

Patterson Avenue and North Sheppard Street; and

Floyd Avenue and North Dooley Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersections to erect all-way stop signs at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, section 2-200 of the Code of the City of Richmond (1993), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the City's Traffic Engineer prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been properly referred to the Department of Public Works and more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since such referral. NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the following intersections:

Patterson Avenue and North Nansemond Street;

Park Avenue and North Nansemond Street;

Hanover Avenue and Tilden Street;

Stuart Avenue and Tilden Street; and

Patterson Avenue and North Sheppard Street[; and

Floyd Avenue and North Dooley Avenue].

- § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersections.

BACKGROUND
