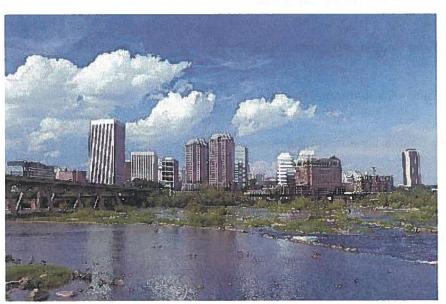

MONTHLY FINANCE REPORT AS OF May 31, 2016





June 15, 2016

Honorable Members of the Governing Council:

The Administration is pleased to present the May 31, 2016 Monthly Financial Report (MFR) pursuant to City Ordinance 2015-213-207.

This MFR is intended to provide informative and relevant financial data to City Council. The report includes highlights of the City's financial condition for the first eleven months of FY2016. This financial information, which is unaudited, includes comparative General Fund revenues and expenditures to date for the periods ending May 31, 2015 and 2016, as well as comparison to the full year budget.

As of May 31, 2016, General Fund revenues totaled \$415.2 million, or 59% of the budgeted annual revenue. Compared to the same period last year, the City has received 6.1% more revenue in this fiscal year than last year at the same time. This is due to several factors. There were transactions not posted in previous months that were posted to the ledger for May close. Although, Intergovernmental Revenues, Service Charges and Fines and Forfeitures continue to lag behind FY2015 amounts, sizeable increases was noted for city taxes (primarily in real estate, personal property, utility gas, and machinery and tools taxes), utility pilot payments, and miscellaneous revenue. Exhibit 1 provides the budgetary comparison for revenues.

As of May 31, 2016, General Fund expenditures totaled \$576.3 million, or 82% of the budgeted expenditures. The target expenditure for this period of the fiscal year should be 92%. The freeze currently in place might explain the reduction in expenditures. Exhibit 2 provides the budgetary comparison for expenditures.

Exhibit 3 presents General Fund revenues by categories and compares the revenues to date to the same period last year.

Exhibit 4 depicts General Fund budget and expenditure by agency for the period ending May 31, 2016.

Exhibit 5 provides summary encumbrances by department totaling \$16.2 million. Department of Public Works (DPW) and Information Technology (DIT) are agencies with large encumbrances. DPW's encumbrances are for grass cutting, leaf collection, waste and trash removal services. DIT's encumbrances are for paper and printing services, wireless communication and other information technology services for the City.

(IN MILLIONS)

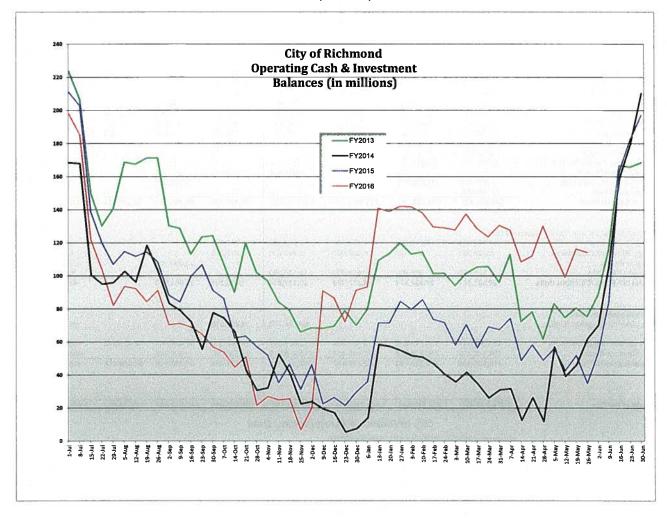
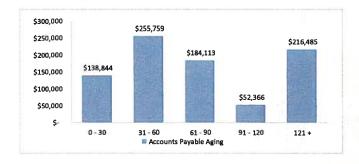

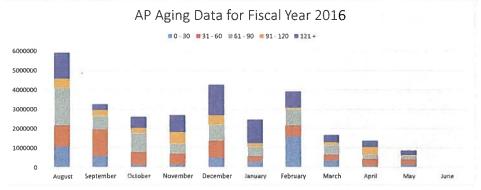

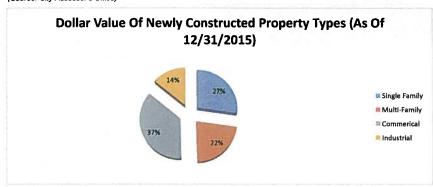
