§ 1. That Chapter 2, Article III, Division 2 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby amended and reordained by **adding therein a new** section numbered 2-91 as follows:

Sec. 2-91. License to use non-City real property.

The Chief Administrative Officer, on behalf of the City, may enter into license agreements or similar documents to permit the City to use real property not owned by the City, provided that (i) the period of time for which the City is allowed to use the real property is not greater than five
