Greater Richmond Transit Company (GRTC) System's CARE and CARE Plus Service

GRTC CEO David Green advised the committee that he was present to answer questions from the committee regarding the CARE and CARE Plus Services offered by GRTC.

Chair Ellen Robertson reported that several complaints had been received regarding the timing as it relates to picking up riders and the wait time riders are experiencing. She stated that an extensive report was received indicating that there was a significant shortage of operators that affected the delivery of services to riders. Chair Robertson asked Mr. Green to elaborate on actions proposed to address the deficiency and quality of the services.

Mr. Green reported that a support, from the contractor's general office, was provided in the form of a recruiter who worked to hire more drivers and an overall evaluation of the operation was currently underway. Mr. Green also reported that a report would be provided the end of March regarding findings.

Chief of Transit Operations Tim Barham advised the committee that new operator training classes were underway and will continue on a monthly bases until staffing levels are met to accommodate services offered.
