<u>Transforming Virginia's Juvenile Justice System to an Enhanced Rehabilitative</u> <u>Model</u>

Deron Phipps, director of Policy and Planning for the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice, provided updated information relating to the juvenile direct care population and budget reductions within the juvenile justice system. Mr. Phipps stated that the use of large correctional facilities is trending downward and smaller facilities are being proposed within Virginia. Mr. Phipps also stated that the proposed transformation plan will improve public safety, gives proximity of youth to their homes and includes new facilities designed for rehabilitation, education, modern technology and dedicated treatment space. Mr. Phipps stated that the transformation will offer more alternatives for communities and will assist in keeping recidivism rates low.
