This resolution was further amended by Resolution No. 2010-R141-173, adopted November 8, 2010, which revised the process of appointing the tenant representatives to the board.

The **remaining** Council **appointees and the Mayor's appointee** other than the Director of Public Works or the designee thereof **shall not** be subject to any requirement that they maintain a residence or a principal place of employment in the city. All other aspects of the commission and its membership not addressed in this division shall be governed by Chapter 2, Article V, Division 1 of the City Code.
