Ms. Pitts,

Thank you for meeting with me on October 23<sup>rd</sup> for the referenced project. I am requesting approval for the windows which were replaced more than 6 months ago. I now know it was an oversight on my part and I should have submitted a Certificate of Appropriateness for approval. The following are reasons why the windows were replaced:

- A. The building has been a rooming house for more than 50 years. The windows were in very poor condition due to rot and termite damage and the sashes were not operating as needed. There was excessive air infiltration loss and windows were beyond repairing and needed to be replaced. I do not have any photos of the existing windows that were replaced.
- B. The inside of the building had a lot of termite damage. We had to gut everything from the inside of the building and approximately 50% of the floor joists had to be replaced.
- C. The demolition, building, electrical, mechanical, plumbing, and drywall permits and the final certificate of occupancy required by the City of Richmond were all obtained and approved.
- D. Several buildings in the adjoining blocks have recently installed vinyl windows.

E. Additionally, the windows on the sides and back of the building are not visible from Grace Street and back alley. The garage apartment on the back blocks the view of the windows in the alley. The original windows on the side and back of the building were six over six and the windows on the front were one over one. Several windows on the side were replaced over time and did not match the original windows. The windows were beyond repair from the inside.

F. The new windows are the same design but of a different material required by the City of Richmond. The wood trim on the windows on the outside of the building have been painted white. If required, we can change the color of the wood trim.

All original windows had storm sashes and material type of windows were not visible from the outside. I am requesting your approval for keeping vinyl windows as installed. If required to do so, I agree to install storm windows for the windows facing Grace Street, like the previously existing windows. It will be very difficult for the tenants if the windows are replaced while the apartments are occupied.

The building now has four luxury apartments unlike before when it was a rooming house. The tenants are hard working professionals that are employed by VCU and the Governor's Office. The renovation work has added significant aesthetics to the building and the Grace Street neighborhood, even if the original windows were replaced.
