ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY This Resolution is requested to support the Resolution approved by the Richmond School Board on January 3, 2017 to develop an Education Compact among all Richmond elected leaders on the shared mission to meet the needs of Richmond students, staff and schools to improve academic outcomes of Richmond students and the well-being of families while expanding the opportunities for success available to students of the City of Richmond.

BACKGROUND

By the Resolution adopted on January 3, 2017, the Richmond School Board of the City of Richmond affirmed its intentions to work collaboratively with the City of Richmond, including Mayor Levar M. Stoney and the Richmond City Council, on the shared mission of improving the academic outcomes of Richmond students and the well-being of families while expanding the opportunities for success available to students of the City of Richmond.

Richmond City Council joins in this cooperative agreement with Richmond Public Schools and Mayor Levar M. Stoney to develop an Education Compact.

The Resolution passed by Richmond Public Schools is as follows:
