Replace wooden fence with brick wall.

The applicant requests approval to replace a wooden privacy fence in the rear yard of a single family residence in the West Grace Street Old and Historic District with a brick wall. The applicant proposes to match an existing brick wall that partially encloses the rear yard. This application is the result of enforcement activity.

Staff recommends approval of the project as submitted. The proposed brick wall matches the existing wall that partially encloses the rear yard of the property. The *Richmond Old and Historic Districts Handbook and Design Review Guidelines* state that a new fence or wall should be constructed using materials and designs appropriate to the District (pg. 76, #4). In addition to the brick walls on the subject property, brick is a common material found at the rear of many properties within the block.
