PURPOSE: To amend Ordinance No. 2016-053, which adopted the General Fund Budget for Fiscal Year 2017, transferring \$35,000 from the Department of Economic & Community Development to the Non-Departmental agency Carytown, Inc., for the purpose of making a grant to support litter cleanup activities in the Carytown area.

REASON: In the FY 2016 Adopted Budget the Council amended the budget for the Department of Economic & Community Development by increasing the operating budget by \$35,000 to allow staff to work with the Carytown Merchants Association and Venture Richmond to conduct litter cleanup activities in the Carytown area. This increase was also approved for FY 17, therefore these funds were included in the Department's FY17 base budget. The City Attorney's Office has advised that in order to make the grant for FY17 these funds must be transferred to the Non-Departmental budget, which requires a budget amendment.

RECOMMENDATION: City Administration recommends approval.

BACKGROUND: The FY 2016 Adopted Budget included a Council amendment for the Department of Economic & Community Development, increasing the operating budget by \$35,000 to allow staff to work with the Carytown Merchants Association and Venture Richmond to conduct litter cleanup activities in the Carytown area. At that time, this increase was also approved for FY 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT/COST: \$35,000 will be transferred from the Department of Economic & Community Development's operating budget to the Non-Departmental budget.
