EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

1. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to submit an application to the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development Industrial Revitalization Fund on behalf of the Better Housing Coalition for a grant of \$600,000 for the purpose of the rehabilitation and adaptive reuse of commercial and retail space, including the possibility of an affordable child care center, as part of a mixed-use and mixed-income development of the property located at 3200 West Broad Street.

MOTIONS TO AMEND

- 2. To amend Ord. No. 2014-093, which establishes an Advisory Task Force for the Economic Revitalization of South Richmond to provide advice to the Council, the Mayor and other City agencies concerning strategies and initiatives to improve the economic health of and promote economic development in certain Enterprise Zones areas and along certain corridors of South Richmond, to modify various provisions relating to the establishment of the Task Force.
- 3. To amend Ord. No. 2017-018, which amends and reordains Ord. No. 82-7-16, adopted Feb. 8, 1982, as previously amended by Ord. No. 2007-98-69, adopted Apr. 9, 2007, which authorized the special use of the property known as 301 West Franklin Street for the purpose of a motel, together with accessory off-street parking, to authorize the installation of two canopy signs, upon certain terms and conditions, to incorporate revised plans.
- 4. To amend Ord. No. 2017-024, which amends City Code §§ 2-871—2-872, concerning the Highway Safety Commission, to rename the Highway Safety Commission as the Safe and Healthy Streets Commission and provide that a quorum of the Commission consists of a majority of the members instead of seven members; and amends ch. 2, art. V, div. 5 of the City Code by adding therein a new § 2-873, concerning the review of transportation-related projects, for the purpose of removing the proposed new § 2-873 and requiring the Department of Public Works to provide the Commission with information concerning transportation-related projects upon request therefor by the Commission.
- 5. To amend Res. No. 2017-R015, which requests that the Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer work with the School Board and other affected governmental agencies to study the potential effects on the City of any proposed development in area of the city bounded by Westwood Avenue to the north, Brook Road to the east, Rennie Avenue to the south, and Loxley Road to the west, including, but not limited to, the effects of such development with regard to historic preservation, schools, stormwater drainage, and traffic, for the purpose of requesting that certain matters be considered in the study.

To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$74,852 from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services; to amend the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Special Fund Budget by creating a new special fund for the Department of Police called the Law Enforcement Intervention Focusing on Education (LIFE) Program Special Fund; and to appropriate the grant funds received to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Special Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to the Department of Police's Law Enforcement Intervention Focusing on Education (LIFE) Program Special Fund by \$74,852 for the purpose of providing prevention and intervention services, resources, and programs to assist in the diversion of youth from the criminal justice system. {Public Safety March 28, 2017}
- 7. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Richmond and the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice for the purpose of enabling the City's Department of Justice Services to provide intake evaluations for direct care to juvenile offenders committed to the Virginia Department of Juvenile Justice. {Public Safety March 28, 2017}
- 8. To amend Ord. No. 2016-057, adopted May 13, 2016, which appropriated and provided funds for financing the school budget for the fiscal year commencing Jul. 1, 2016, and ending Jun. 30, 2017, for the purpose of transferring \$5,500,000 from the Instruction classification to the Pupil Transportation classification. {Education and Human Services April 13, 2017}
- 9. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer, for and on behalf of the City of Richmond, to execute a Commonwealth's Development Opportunity Fund Performance Agreement between the City of Richmond, Owens & Minor Medical, Inc., and the Economic Development Authority of the City of Richmond to facilitate the consolidation of Owens & Minor Medical, Inc.'s current distribution center administrative operations, to improve, equip and operate a new centralized distribution center and administrative operations facility in the city of Richmond, and to set forth the responsibilities of the parties. {Finance and Economic Development April 20, 2017}
- 10. To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept funds in the amount of \$1,500,000 from the Commonwealth's Development Opportunity Fund and to appropriate the increase to the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 General Fund Budget by increasing estimated revenues and the amount appropriated to a new line item in the Non-Departmental agency called the Owens & Minor Medical, Inc. (the Company) Commonwealth Opportunity Fund line item for the purpose of providing funds to the Economic Development Authority to provide a grant to Owens & Minor Medical, Inc., pursuant to a Commonwealth's Development Opportunity Fund Performance Agreement between the City of Richmond, Virginia, Owens & Minor Medical, Inc., and the Economic Development Authority of Richmond, Virginia, dated _____, 2017. {Finance and Economic Development April 20, 2017}
