To erect all-way stop signs at the intersections of North 23 <sup>rd</sup>	d Street and Phaup Street, North 23rd
Street and Selden Street, and North 25th Street and Rosetta St	treet.

WHEREAS, the intersections of North 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and Phaup Street, North 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and Selden Street, and North 25<sup>th</sup> Street and Rosetta Street are located in a populous residential area of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Council that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Richmond and especially the citizens who reside near the aforesaid intersections to erect all-way stop signs at said intersections; and

WHEREAS, section 2-428 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015), as amended, requires an appropriate study by the Department of Public Works prior to the adoption of an ordinance regulating motor vehicle traffic within the City; and

### THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

- § 1. That all-way stop signs shall be erected at the intersections of North 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and Phaup Street, North 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and Selden Street, and North 25<sup>th</sup> Street and Rosetta Street.
- § 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption or such other date as may be fixed by traffic order of the Director of Public Works if, prior to adoption, the all-way stop signs have been erected at the aforesaid intersections.

### ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Patron requests that legislation be drafted for Council's consideration that requires the installation of all-way stop signs at three intersections in the Fairfield area of the City. The intersections are as follows:

- 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and Phaup Street,
   23<sup>rd</sup> Street and Selden Street, and
- 3. 25<sup>th</sup> Street and Rosetta Street.

#### BACKGROUND

Residents' organizations, RRHA, and the RPD acknowledge ongoing speeding and safety problems at these intersections. These areas of Fairfield have experienced continuing and long-term problems with speeding and increased traffic. It is hoped that all-way stops at these intersections will improve driver and pedestrian safety, while preventing crashes.
