PURPOSE: To amend the FY2017 general fund budget by appropriating \$3,540.00 that was received from the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles Animal Friendly license plate program to the Department of Animal Care & Control Budget for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017.

REASON: To appropriate funds as outlined in the Virginia Code 46.2-749, as part of its special license plate program.

RECOMMENDATION: The administration recommends adoption of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND: The Department of Motor Vehicles sells the Animal Friendly license plate which is authorized by Virginia Code 46.2-749, as part of its special license plate program. This plate is issued to supporters of dog and cat sterilization programs at a cost of \$25.00 per year in addition to the prescribed fee for vehicle registration. After the first 1,000 sets of plates are sold. \$15.00 of each fee is made available to the locality in which the vehicle is registered, to be used to support sterilization programs for dogs and cats.

The Department of Motor Vehicles sells the Animal Friendly license plate, which is authorized by Virginia Code, §48.2-749.2:7, as part of its special license plate program. This plate is issued to supporters of dog and cat sterilization programs at a cost of \$25.00 per year in addition to the prescribed fee for vehicle registration. After the first 1,000 sets of plates are sold, \$15.00 of each fee is made available to the locality in which the vehicle is registered, to be used to support sterilization programs for dogs and cats.
