The two story accessory building proposed by this application is a cute little thing that would look ideal in Powhatan County, right next to the barn...perhaps a granny flat: the roof awning is a perfect fit for that sort of location.

And is there a stoop at the entrance protected by the awning? And if so, what is proposed for the stoop regarding material and height etc?

The letter from the Department of Historic Resources which accompanies the application states "This Amendment provides information on (two changes and) the proposed siding for a separate, new construction on the property." What Amendment? Did DHR approve the new structure itself with siding going one way on the first floor and another on the second...or only the siding material?

The staff report recommends needed changes but more changes are needed in order for this new building to blend into Union Hill.
