THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEREBY ORDAINS:

§ 1. That sections 9-58, 9-70, and 9-72 of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be

and are hereby **amended** and reordained as follows:

Sec. 9-58. Polling places.

Pursuant to Code of Virginia, §§ 24.2-310 and 24.2-310.1, the polling places for each of

the precincts established in this article shall be as follows:

Sec. 9-70. Precinct 206.

Election precinct 206 shall be described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of North Harrison Street and [-Floyd Avenue; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of Floyd Avenue to the point at which it becomes South Cathedral Place; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of South Cathedral Place to its intersection with North Laurel Street; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of North Laurel Street to its intersection with the centerline of West Main Street; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of West Main Street to its intersection with the northbound lane of South Belvidere Street; thence in a southward direction along the northbound lane of South Belvidere Street to its intersection with the centerline of West Canal Street; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of West Canal Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Adams Street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of South Adams Street to the point at which it becomes North Adams Street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of North Adams Street to its intersection with the eastbound lane of West Broad Street; thence in a westward direction along the eastbound lane of West Broad Street to its intersection with the centerline of North Lombardy Street; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of North Lombardy Street to [the point at which it becomes Stuart Circle; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Stuart Circle to its intersection with the centerlines of Monument Avenue and West Franklin Street; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of West Franklin Street] its intersection with the centerline of Park Avenue; thence in an eastward direction along Park Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of North Harrison Street; thence a [southward] northward direction along the centerline of North Harrison Street to its intersection with [Floyd Avenue] the centerline of the eastbound lane of West Broad Street, the point of the beginning.

Sec. 9-72. - Precinct 208.

Election Precinct 208 shall be described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of North Harrison Street and [West Franklin Street] Park Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of [West Franklin Street to its

intersection with the centerline of Stuart Circle; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Stuart Circle to its intersection with the centerline of Park Avenue; thence in a westward direction along the centerline of] Park Avenue to its intersection with the centerline of North Shields Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of North Shields Avenue; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of Floyd Avenue; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of Floyd Avenue; thence in an eastward direction street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of North Harrison Street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of North Harrison Street to its intersection with the centerline of [West Franklin Street] Park Avenue, the point of beginning.

§ 2. That Chapter 9, Article III of the Code of the City of Richmond (2015) be and is hereby amended and reordained by **adding therein a new** section 9-73.1, as follows:

Sec. 9-73.1. Precinct 214.

Election precinct 214 shall be described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerlines of North Harrison Street and Floyd Avenue; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of Floyd Avenue to the point at which it becomes South Cathedral Place; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of South Cathedral Place to its intersection with North Laurel Street; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of North Laurel Street to its intersection with the centerline of West Main Street; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of West Main Street to its intersection with the northbound lane of South Belvidere Street; thence in a southward direction along the northbound lane of South Belvidere Street to its intersection with the centerline of West Canal Street; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of West Canal Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Belvidere Street; thence in a southward direction along the northbound lane of South Belvidere Street to its intersection with the centerline of West Canal Street; thence in an eastward direction along the centerline of West Canal Street to its intersection with the centerline of South Adams Street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of South Adams Street to the point at which it becomes North Adams Street; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of North Adams Street to its intersection with the eastbound lane of West Broad Street; thence in a westward direction along the eastbound lane of West Broad Street to its intersection with the centerline of North Harrison Street; thence in a southward direction along the centerline of North Harrison Street its intersection with the centerline of Floyd Avenue, the point of the beginning.

§ 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect upon adoption.

ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Ordinance to amend and reordain City Code §30-77, which assigns polling places in the city, to subdivide existing precinct 206 (Dominion Place) and create a new precinct 214 (VCU Library) out of that subdivision and move a portion of existing precinct 208 (Tabernacle) into precinct 206 to ease crowding in precinct 208.

BACKGROUND

Precinct 206 has grown from 1,540 registered voters in January 2011 to 4,344 registered voters in July 2017. The current polling place for precinct 206 – Dominion Place – is physically too small to accommodate the manpower and equipment necessary to process the larger number of voters in a reasonable time. This resulted in unacceptably long lines at this polling place in November 2016. Downsizing the size of this precinct by subdividing it into two precincts is the most viable solution.

This Ordinance proposes to subdivide existing precinct 206 and create a new precinct 214 out of that subdivision and move a portion of existing precinct 208

into precinct 206 to ease crowding in precinct 208.

The proposed creation of Precinct 214 is VCU Library, located 901 Park Avenue, Richmond, Virginia 23284.

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed new precinct will not have an impact on voting equipment needs until the next presidential election as existing inventories can accommodate this additional precinct until that time. However, the change will require six more officers of election, costing \$880.00 per election. It will also cost an estimated \$3,033 to mail the mandatory notice of precinct and polling place change to the affected voters.

There is no known budget request at this time as the need for additional funding to meet this cost is not currently known. If there is no primary in June, the Office of the General Registrar has indicated, the costs can be absorbed by their office. It will not be known until April 2018 whether or not there will be a primary in June 2018.
