PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to accept grant funds in the amount of \$5,000 from the Virginia No Kid Hungry Campaign and to appropriate the increase to the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (DPRCF) Special Fund Budgets for the purpose of increasing the number of healthy meals served through the US Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) Summer Food Service Program (SFSP), which is sponsored through the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (DPRCF).

REASON: The City of Richmond through its Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (DPRCF) is seeking approval to accept a grant award in the amount of \$5,000; the award is being made by the Virginia No Kid Hungry Campaign. The grant will provide additional funding that will aid in increasing the number of meals served to children in low-income areas.

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that this funding is appropriated to the Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities Special Fund Budget FY2018.

BACKGROUND: The Department (DPRCF) has sponsored the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) for more than 40 years. The SFSP is the premier child nutrition service program providing children with healthy meals during summer months. The programs provided over 218,000 meals to youth at approximately 100 different feeding sites throughout the Richmond area in FY 2016-2017.

SFSP feeding sites are located to ensure that every child who wants to participate is within walking distance. This grant agreement period is June 19 thru September 30, 2017.

FISCAL IMPACT/COST: The City will receive \$5,000 in grant funding to support materials, supplies, and education to program participants.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS: The acceptance of this award will allow the Department's SFSP to expand awareness and increase the number of meals served to program youth.
