PURPOSE: To authorize the Chief Administrative Officer to amend the FY2018 General Fund Budget by appropriating a grant award in the amount of \$4,500 from the Virginia Commission for the Arts through the Local Government Challenge Grant Program to the Non-Departmental Budget for the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.

REASON: The City received a \$4,500 grant award on behalf the Cadence Theatre Company, a local arts organization, and CultureWorks, the organization managing the Arts and Culture Funding Consortium and administering local government funding to the member arts organizations. The award will be equally divided and passed-through Cadence Theatre Company and Culture-Works, with each organization receiving \$2,250

RECOMMENDATION: The administration recommends adoption of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND: Each year, the Virginia Commission for the Arts challenges local governments to fund arts organization in their communities and provides up to \$5,000 (this year up to \$4,500 due to state budget considerations) on a dollar-for-dollar basis for the local government to pass-through to a local arts organization. This year, the City was approached by Cadence Theatre Company and CultureWorks to submit a Local Government Challenge Grant application to the

Virginia Commission for the Arts on their behalf. The City submitted a grant application that included both organizations which was subsequently awarded in the amount of \$4,500.

To our Local Government Challenge Grant applicants:

The final numbers have come in for the FY18 state budget for the Virginia Commission for the Arts. Since the final budget was approved, we have had to find additional savings.

Part of the Commission's original savings strategies included a contingency plan to cap the Local Government Challenge Grants at \$4,500. This morning, the Commission Board made the difficult decision to adopt that \$4,500 cap for FY18. We regret this painful but necessary step to address the funding shortfall we had hoped to avoid. We have not previously reduced our Local Government Challenge Grant funds, and we hope to avoid doing so in the future.

We hope that despite the reductions we have had to make to make, you and our local government partners can find a way to maintain your level of commitment to your community arts organizations and programs.
