WHEREAS, for the full implementation of this plan to adjust the compensation of sworn police officers, the projected additional appropriations required above the appropriation made in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018, is [$\frac{2,222,429}$] $\frac{22,902,714}$ in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019, and [$\frac{4,147,080}$] $\frac{55,008,092}{100}$ in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, for the full implementation of this plan to adjust the compensation of sworn firefighters, the projected additional appropriations required above the appropriation made in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2018, is \$1,980,000 in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019, and \$3,630,000 in the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2020; and
