

### PUBLIC HEARING: MAR 28 2016 AT 6 P.M.

WHEREAS, section 36-11 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, provides for the appointment and tenure of commissioners appointed by the Council of the City of Richmond to the Board of Commissioners for the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority but does not address term limits for the Commissioners of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Council is now of the opinion that the tenure of the commissioners to the Board of Commissioners for the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority should be limited to no more than two consecutive full terms; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Richmond that the Council establish a policy that the terms of the commissioners to the Board of Commissioners for the Richmond

### ORDINANCE/RESOLUTION SUMMARY

Patron requests that an ordinance be drafted limiting persons to no more than two consecutive terms as a Commissioner on the Board of Commissioners of the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority (RRHA).

### BACKGROUND

The tenants of public housing are entitled to a representative on housing authority boards according to State and federal laws. See, Va Code Section 36-11 and US Code Title 42, Section 1437(b)(1)(A).

The City Council appoints Commissioners to the Board of Governors of RRHA. Currently, there are no limits to the number of terms a Commissioner can serve on the Board. The purpose of this proposal is to establish term limitations.
