Project Description:

Convert existing window to door for roof access.

The applicant requests approval to convert a second story window to a door to provide roof access to this three-story brick commercial building in the Boulevard Old and Historic District. The applicant is proposing to install a contemporary painted steel door frame with a painted full-lite wood door in the existing opening. The alterations will not require widening the existing window opening.

Staff recommends approval of the project, with conditions. The application states that a new door opening is required to provide roof maintenance access on the single story addition on the rear of the structure. The *Guidelines* note that changes to existing windows along a secondary elevation will be considered on a case-by-case basis (pg. 67, #8). Due to the window's location centered above the one-story portion of the structure, the proposed alteration will be minimally visible from the public right-of-way. The new entrance will be distinguishable from the historic openings and will not require altering the width of the opening. <u>Staff recommends that the window head height be maintained, the window being removed remain on site, and the door color be administratively reviewed by staff.</u>

It is the assessment of staff that, with the conditions above, the application is consistent with the Standards for Rehabilitation and New Construction outlined in Sections 30-930.7(b) and (c) of the City Code, as well as with the *Richmond Old and Historic Districts Handbook and Design Review Guidelines,* specifically the page cited above, adopted by the Commission for review of Certificates of Appropriateness under the same section of the code.
