Whereas, the mission of the World Kindness Movement is to inspire individuals and nations to create a kinder world through establishing independent kindness programs and projects in cities, schools and communities across the globes;

Whereas, International Random Acts of Kindness Week is celebrated during the second full week of February of each year, National Random Acts of Kindness Day was celebrated February 17, 2017, and World Kindness Day is celebrated on November 13, 2017;

Whereas, many nations and states have agreed together that November 13th of each year is celebrated to promote the values of kindness, unity and love; and

Therefore be it resolved, that Richmond City Council designates November 13, 2017 as Richmond Kindness Day in recognition of "World Kindness Day" in Richmond, VA; and

Be it further RESOLVED, that the Council encourages all residents to reach out to others with acts of giving and gestures of goodwill, ongoing support for international collaboration of our nation's governments and its residents to create kinder and peaceful societies.
