ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION NO.:

PURPOSE: To name parcel W0000700025, at the corner of E Texas Canal and Kansas, "Riverview Community Park" by way of a request from the Maymont Civic League and supported by the Friends of Riverview Park, Richmond Area Skateboard Alliance, and Kiwanis International.

REASON: The Maymont Civic League has formally requested the park parcel at Kansas and Southampton Avenues be officially named Riverview Community Park. This is the name of the community in which the park sits.

RECOMMENDATION: The Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities recommends approval of officially naming the aforementioned park parcel "Riverview Community Park" as it resonates with the community and the surrounding parcels.

BACKGROUND: In June of 2016, representatives from the Maymont Civic League reached out to the Deputy Director of Parks, Recreation and Community Facilities (PRCF) and the Operations Manager requesting an official naming of the park parcel at Kansas and Southampton Avenues, currently known as Texas Avenue Skate Park. PRCF convened a meeting of representatives from the Maymont Civic League, Friends of Riverview Community Park, and Richmond Area Skateboard Alliance to review needs and begin plans to develop the parcel of land as a park to meet the needs of the community.

The Friends of Riverview Park engaged Kiwanis International as a supporter for park enhancement, financial support, and construction of the parcel. Thus far, a layout for the park has been designed by Kiwanis International, a community garden approved by Council, and an expansion of the footprint of the skate park. A number of meetings were held to discuss the improvements proposed and the proper course of action needed to receive approval from the City allowing the Friends of Riverview Community Park, Maymont Civic Association, and Richmond Area Skateboard Alliance to proceed. The community partners are currently completing the application for the Urban Design Committee to approve the latest proposed park improvements including a walking trail, parking, and playground.
