EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION

1. To approve the issuance by the Richmond Redevelopment and Housing Authority of its multifamily housing revenue bonds in an amount up to \$20,000,000.00 for the acquisition, construction, renovation, rehabilitation and equipping of an approximately 159-unit multifamily residential rental housing project to be known as Richmond ArtistSpace Lofts located at 716 Jefferson Davis Highway in the city of Richmond.
